



VACANCIES

The Institute of Chemistry Ceylon is the successor to the Chemical Society of Ceylon (founded in 1941) and was established in the year 1971 for the general advancement of the science and practice of chemistry. The Institute was incorporated by Act of Parliament No.15 of 1972.

Applications are invited for the following posts from the citizens of Sri Lanka who possess the qualifications and experience specified under each post as given below;

1. SENIOR ACCOUNTANT

Qualifications and experience:

1. Full qualification in ICASL/CIMA/ACCA. In addition, a degree in the field of Finance or Accountancy is preferred.

AND

2. Minimum of five years' experience in a similar capacity. Candidates with exposure and experience in private higher educational institutes/private sector service industry preferred.

AND

3. Good knowledge in accounting packages preferably QB, sound IT knowledge and exposure to computerized accounting environment, handling corporate tax and experience in preparing financial accounts and budgets.

AND

4. Excellent supervisory, communication & interpersonal skills & high level of accuracy. Good written and oral communication skills in English

Other terms:

Salary : Negotiable

Appointment : The appointment is in the permanent cadre subject to three-year probation period which may be extended at the discretion of the Council of the Institute of Chemistry Ceylon

2. AUDIT ASSISTANT

Qualifications and experience:

1. Minimum of one year of experience in internal auditing, external auditing, or a finance-related role.

2. Partly qualified in AAT/ACCA/CIMA/CA.

3. Experience in QuickBooks (QB) will be an added advantage.

4. Good computer literacy, particularly in MS Office applications.

Other terms:

Age : Shall be less than 25 years.

Appointment : The appointment as the Audit Assistant is initially for 01-year contract renewable depending on the performance.

Allowance : A monthly all-inclusive allowance of Rs. 66,300/- is paid.
